In accordance with the MPHPT announcement No. 460 (July 1, 2003; on changes in numbers to be granted to future Specified Radio Equipment), DSP Research, Inc. has changed the approval numbers as follows.

These changes will automatically affect applications accepted beginning July 1, 2003. Applications accepted on or before June 30, 2003 will not be affected by these changes.

Main changes

- 1. The Classification of certification Body '03' has been changed to '003'.
- 2. The symbols that show the classification of radio equipment have been discontinued.
- 3. The year of a new application has been added to the approval numbers.
- 4. The numbers that show the classification of the application have been added.



The indication items are as follows:

1. MPHPT mark

The diameter of the mark must be 5mm or greater, unless certified equipment is smaller than 100 cc in volume in which case, the diameter of the mark may be 3mm or greater.



2. Material

The label will be made of a durable material with a strong adhesive.



3. ID Number

Technical Condition Conformity 'Type Approval ID Number' will follow the following requirements:

- 1) The first three letters of Type Approval ID Number '003' show the classification of the Certification Body, which is fixed by Ministerial Ordinance, and the next two (or one) letters show the type of equipment.
- 2) Nine letters follow: the first, are issued by DSPR; followed by two digits indicating the year of the Approval; and then, three unique numbers issued by DSPR.
